

Harmonized Commodity Code & Consignee's EORI Number Form for Shipments Traveling to ICS2 Mandate Region

Instructions for the shipper or exporter:

- Mandatory requirements are to submit EORI and HS codes either electronically or at acceptance.
- Please read the entire form and provide the information below for each AWB you are shipping.
- ICS2 information is required for all shipments with destination to, or in transit through, one of the 27 countries in the European Union (EU), Northern Ireland, Norway or Switzerland.
- Provide this information along with all shipping documents to the American Airlines Cargo acceptance agent at the origin station. The acceptance agent will record your information in the American Airlines Cargo booking system for compliance with the ICS2 mandate.

<u>Note</u>: Shipper or authorized agent is responsible for providing and for the accuracy of the information on this form. American Airlines is not responsible for incomplete or inaccurate information.

What is ICS2?

ICS2 is an automated entry process that applies to **all cargo to and transiting through the 27 EU member states**, **Northern Ireland, Norway, and Switzerland**. This process monitors the security of the EU's external border. Please note that ICS2 applies to all cargo with a destination within or transit via the ICS2 mandate region. At American Airlines Cargo, we have prepared for the new requirements by adapting our processes and systems to ensure full compliance. The successful introduction of the changes required by the ICS2 regulation will also depend on your active participation and compliance.

What does this mean for me?

American Airlines Cargo will require the full data *before acceptance* to fulfill a carrier's responsibility regarding filing. This means that we now require the following information for shipments bound for the ICS2 mandate region at time of tender:

- The first six digits of the Harmonized Commodity Code (HS)
- The consignee's Economic Operator's Registration and Identification number (EORI) * Not applicable for shipments only transiting thru the ICS2 mandate regions

We ask customers to include these new data elements on shipping source documents (Master Air Waybill; House Air Waybill & Consolidation Manifest). The information must be transmitted to American Airlines Cargo <u>before tender</u>. Shipments without this information will not be accepted and may incur additional fees.
