Customer Requirements Prior to Day of Departure:

- Provide forecast of volumes, days of week and destinations
- The importer of record must provide Power of Attorney to broker of their choice, for customs clearance for shipments with a final destination within the United States
- All cooling service charges will be added to the air waybill

Schedule of Charges	
Confirmed Cooler (PA)	\$0.04/Kilo – minimum \$80.00 USD

Forwarder Responsibilities:

- Show the breakdown of the confirmed cooler charges in the "OTHER CHARGES AND DESCRIPTION" field on the air waybill
- Total the charges in the" DUE CARRIER" field on the air waybill
- Show "Notify MIA AA Cargo Perishable Handling Agent (786) 591-3111 / 3112" in the HANDLING INFORMATION field on the air waybill
- Send details of shipment prior to tender to miacargo.precool@aa.com and your sales account manager
- Send copies of the invoices, phyto-sanitary certificate and air waybill to <u>miacargo.import@aa.com</u> and notify miacargo.precool@aa.com
