



Free Trade Zone Notification

American Airlines Cargo is committed to serving your worldwide cargo needs, but to do so, we need your assistance when you tender a shipment from a Free Trade Zone.

Since American Airlines Cargo must substantiate when a shipment is tendered from a Free Trade Zone, it is necessary for the Shipper to provide a certified letter and/or a copy of the original certificate issued by the local government and/or Free Trade Zone authorities. This information should include the terms of the Free Trade Zone Agreement, the effective date and the expiration date (if applicable).

Additionally, this information should accompany each shipment when it is tendered to American Airlines Cargo. By law, if a customer fails to provide this information at the time of tender, American Airlines Cargo must collect the appropriate taxes.

If the local government and/or Free Trade Zone authorities discontinue these exemptions, it is the Shipper's responsibility to inform American Airlines Cargo in writing. If the Shipper fails to inform us beforehand, the Shipper and/or customer will be subject to all taxes, penalties and fines imposed by the applicable governments.
